Haynes Township Board Minutes March 4, 2020

The regular meeting of the Haynes Township Board was called to order at 7:00 PM, on March 4, 2020 by Supervisor Effrick, members present: Clerk Schefferly, Trustee Quick, Treasurer Campbell and Trustee Campbell

Public present: Sheriff Stephenson and Mrs. Stephenson

Minutes of the February 5, 2020 board meeting were read and it was moved by Trustee Quick and seconded by Supervisor Effrick to approve the minutes, all ayes motion carried.

Sheriff Stephenson came to discuss the Sheriff department. He talked to the board about grants the department had received and what they were for. He said that the department had received used radios from Genesee County and had shared them with local fire departments. The Sheriff Department had also updated the patrol cars with computers. He also talked about elder abuse and said that they encouraged anyone that suspected anyone being abused or taken advantage of to call the Sheriff Dept. and they would investigate

The Treasurer report: \$336,198.06 in the general fund. It was moved by Clerk Schefferly and Seconded by Supervisor Effrick to approve the treasurer report, all ayes motion carried.

Vouchers #5824 thru #5840 were presented to the board for payment. It was moved by Trustee Quick and seconded by Supervisor Effrick to pay the bills presented in the amount of \$4,683.98, all ayes motion carried.

The board received "Agreement To Provide Land Division Act Services" from the county, this agreement will remain in effect until December 31, 2020. Supervisor Effrick made a motion to approve the agreement, seconded by Trustee Quick all ayes motion carried.

The board received "Contract For Services" from the county, effective from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021. This service would be for the tax rolls etc. Clerk Schefferly made a motion to approve the Contract for Services agreement, seconded by Supervisor Effrick, all ayes motion carried.

The board also received a bill to renew the GIS contract with the annual contract fee of \$50.00. Supervisor Effrick made a motion to renew the contract, seconded by Trustee Campbell, all ayes motion carried.

Clerk Schefferly said that the renewal for the road millage would have to put on the August ballot. Clerk Schefferly read the millage language to the board and made a motion to put the renewal of the road millage on the August ballot, seconded by Supervisor Effrick, all ayes motion carried.
